2. Give your form and payment to Denise Hyde at a regularly scheduled Guild meeting.

Note: If you register in person at a regularly scheduled Guild meeting, your membership card will be issued right away. If you register by mail, you will receive your membership card at the next scheduled Guild meeting.

To process your membership, we need some basic information about you. This information is used to:

- a) Create a membership list that is shared with all active members of the Guild. This allows members to contact each other between meetings and for the Phone Captain to call in the case of meeting cancellation due to bad weather.
- b) Create an email distribution list. This allows Guild executive members such as the Newsletter Editor and the Cuddle Quilt Coordinator to send information to all members on email.
