

50/50: Please bring change. It is \$2.00 per square.



RST = RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER SNF = STITCH AND FLIP
Sew all seams RST and with a 1/4" seam allowance. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS



1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (4) B-squares and (12) C-squares.
2. Align (1) marked C-square with the top-right corner of (1) A-rectangle, RST. Sew on the drawn diagonal line. Trim excess corner fabric to 1/4". Press toward the corner. Next, align (1) marked C-square with the bottom-left corner of the same A-rectangle, RST. Sew, trim, and press as before to make (1) A/C SNF unit. Repeat to make (4) total units.
3. Repeat Step 2 with marked B-squares, marked C-squares, and D-rectangles to make (4) total B/C/D SNF units.

5. Arrange (4) Pinwheel Units as shown below. Sew the units together into pairs. Next, sew the pairs together to make Block 2. Block 2 should measure 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" unfinished.



Your block is complete!

4. Sew (1) A/C SNF unit and (1) B/C/D SNF unit together as shown below to make (1) Pinwheel Unit. Repeat to make (4) total units.



Due to the hand-crafted nature of batiks, fabric may vary from images.

Turn right on Ethelbert (if you are coming from downtown) or turn left if you are coming from the Azilda side. See map.

Follow Ethelbert to White Avenue and turn right. The park will be on your right.

What to bring:

You will be cutting out hexagons and circles.

Scissors

Pencil

Glue stick

Small cutting mat

6-inch quilting ruler plus any other notion items you would like to have.



All other needed supplies will be contained in the kit you will be receiving at the workshop. Also, bring lunch and any beverages you wish to have during the day.

Please note: We had earlier anticipated a pop-up shop hosted by Barb Attrill. Unfortunately, that will not be possible.



- 60/8 Universal - silk, organza, chiffon, sheer
- 70/10 Universal - Blouse & lightweight dress fabric
- 70/10 Microtex - Batiste, crepe de chine, microfiber
- 75/11 Stretch - Interlock knit, lycra
- 75/11 Quilting - Quilting through various batting
- 80/12 Embroidery - rayon thread for decorative stitches & embroidery
- 80/12 Universal - Cotton, linen, wool
- 80/12 Metallic - Metallic & decorative thread
- 90/14 Jeans - Denim, canvas
- 90/14 Stretch - Fleece, knit, faux suede & leather
- 110 & 120 (not wing) - wonderful for pinstitching in heirloom fabric

Standard Quilt Sizes

Measurements for Beds, Comforter, Coverlet, and Bedspreads

The measurements include a drop that hangs over the mattress on 3 sides. It does not cover the pillows. Add an additional 10 inches to length if you want to have a tuck for the pillows.
